Dignity and compassion are among Mary Wade's Core Values. We treat your loved one with respect, dignity and compassion from the day they first arrive to the day they leave us. We feel your loved one should go to their final resting place with dignity and compassion. When your loved one has passed away and it is time for them to go to their funeral home we cover your loved one with a beautiful quilt. We also have a flag quilt for our Veterans. Staff gather and accompany your loved one to Mary Wade's front entrance. We feel they entered from our front door and should take their leave through the same door, with respect, dignity and grace. It assures that life has meaning, death is a natural part of life and it honors the deceased. We also light candles in the lobby, place a single white rose with a memorial sign to honor your loved one. We also have a memorial service with the staff to allow family members, friends and our staff to talk, grieve and share memories of your loved one.

It is our mission to have our residents die with dignity, when the time has come, and to leave with dignity. We hope this process makes this time a more peaceful one knowing we truly are honored to care for your loved one.
